

CRANLEIGH SCHOOL – Woodland Workshop

The Woodland Workshop is a new sustainable school building in which woodworking and wood sculpture can be taught. It was self-built by the schools in house artist / carpenter with outside assistance from sub contractors. Nye Saunders produced designs, working drawings and on site professional advice

Locally sourced Chestnut was used for the main structure. The building also features a wood pellet boiler for heating, rainwater harvesting, blown paper insulation to give high thermal performance and low energy lighting.
